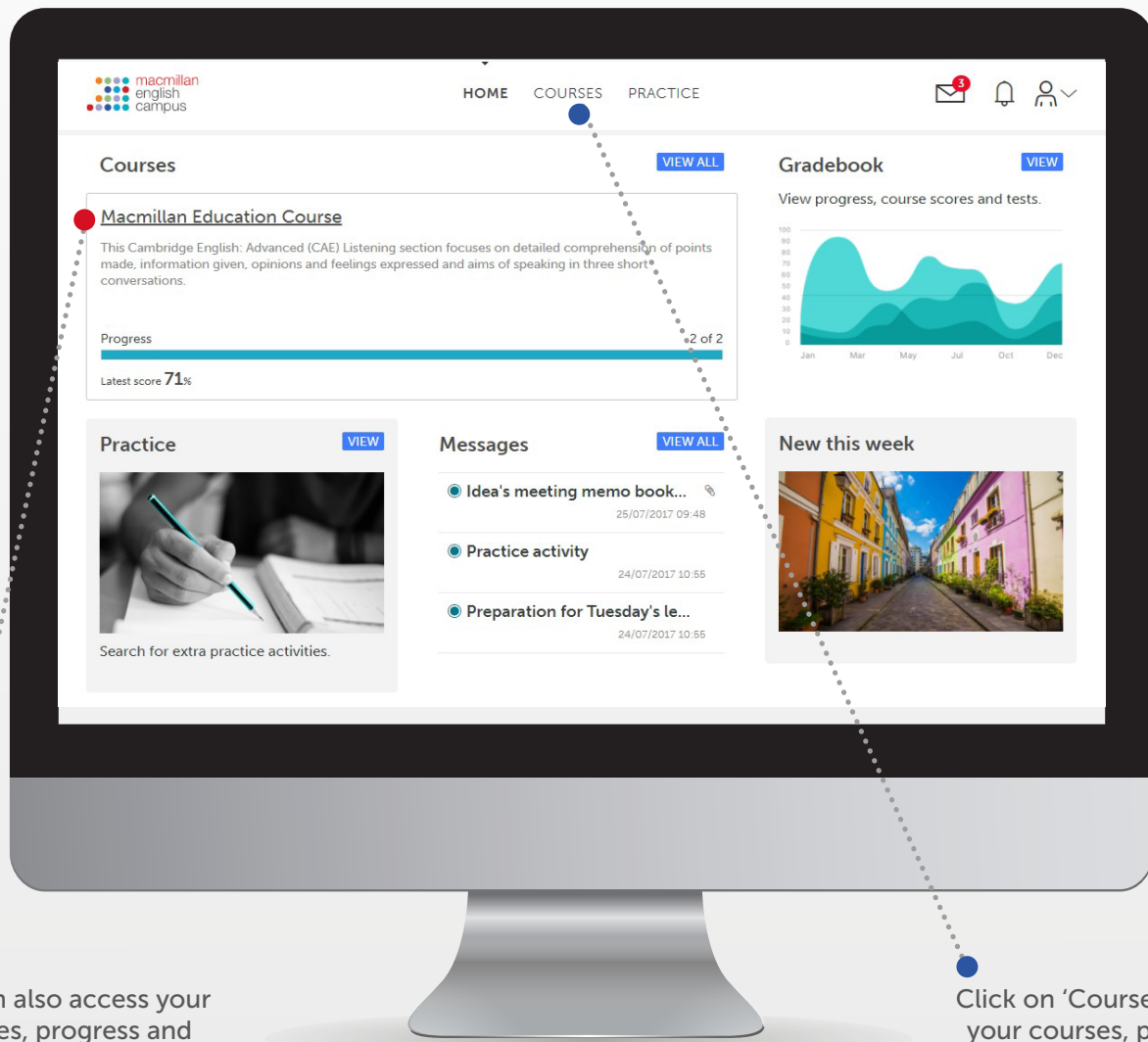


Student guide to courses, activities and scores

Click on 'Courses' to see your courses, progress and scores on the courses page

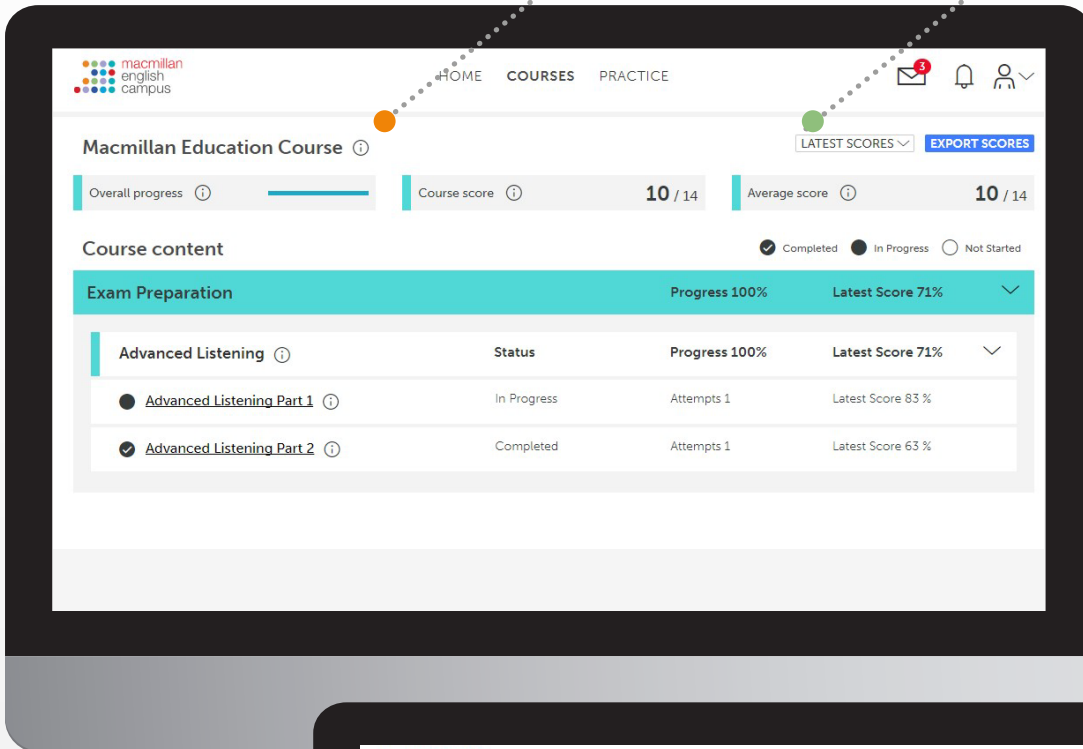
Course view

- Latest score

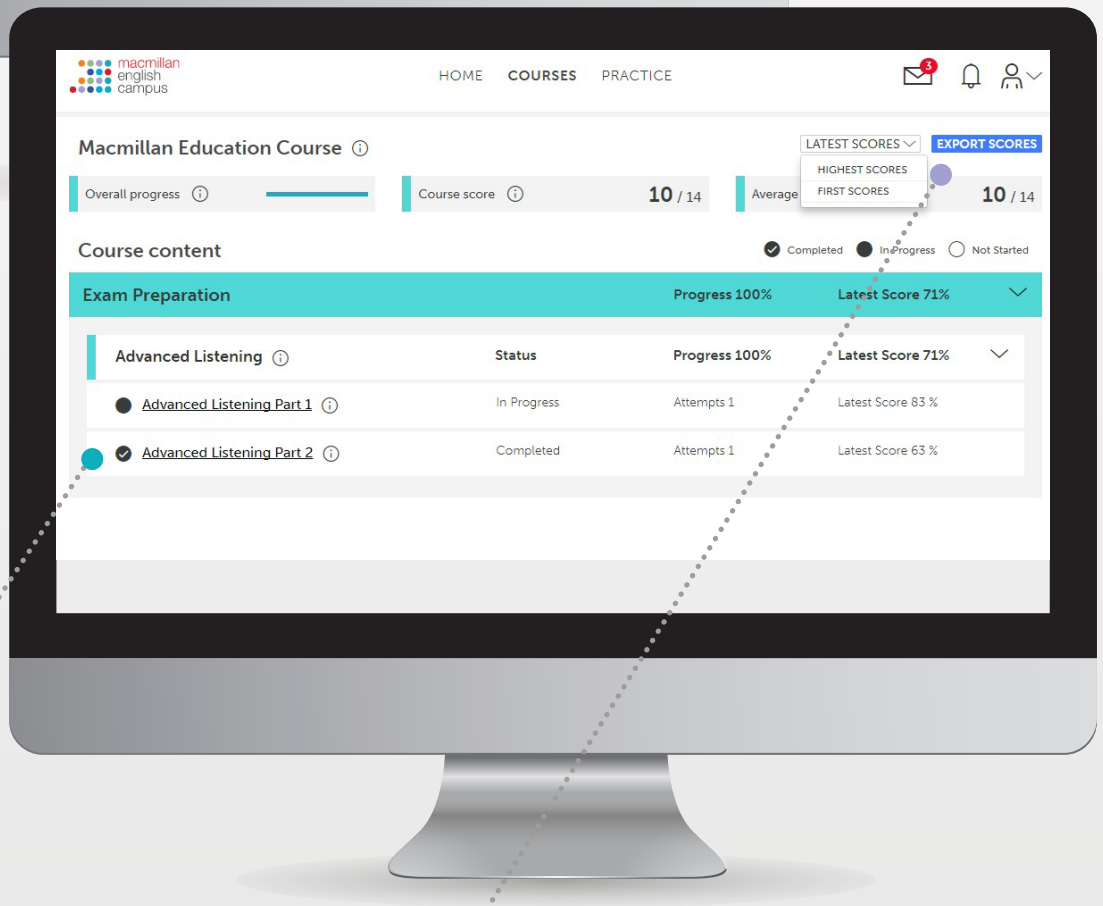
Click on the information icon for further information.

Click on the name of the activity to open and complete the activity. If you have completed the activity, you will see a summary of your scores.

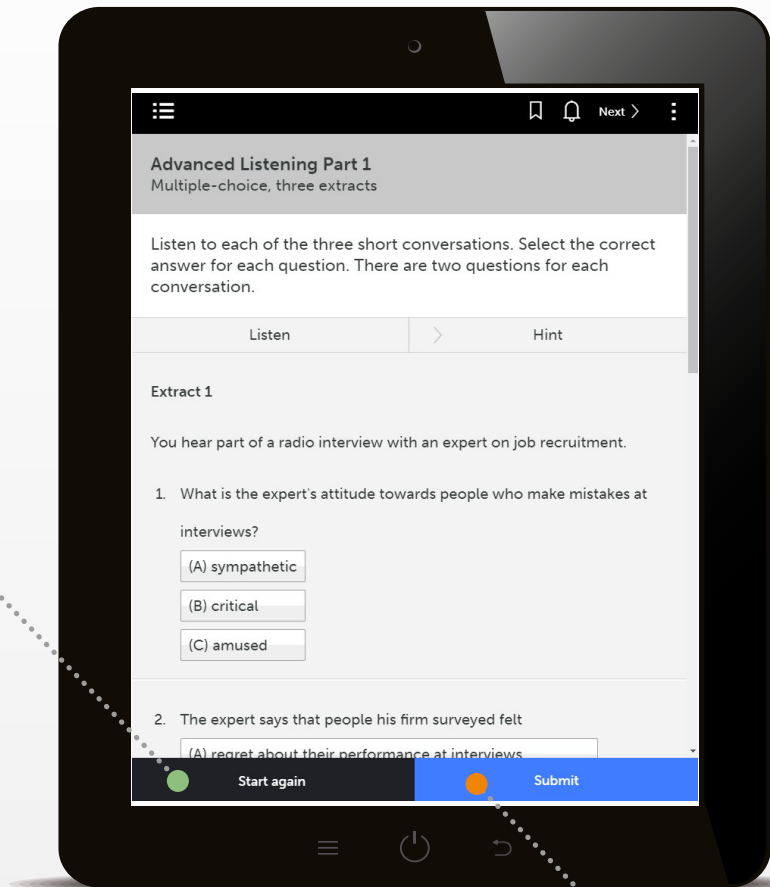
Click on 'Export scores' to download your progress report.



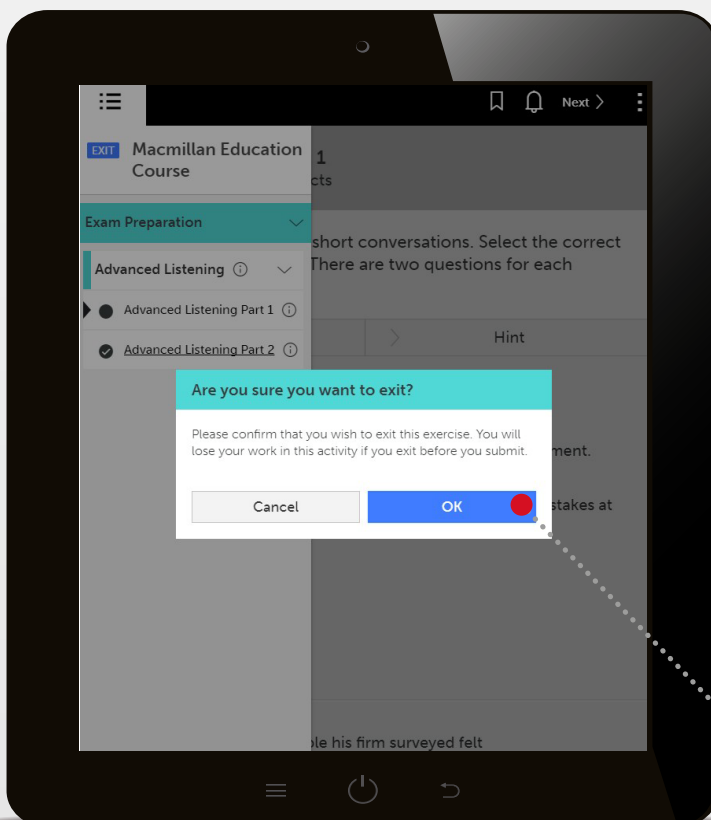
Activity example

When you click on an activity title, an activity will open like this.

You can attempt the activity again by clicking 'Start again'. You can try activities as many times as you like.



Remember to submit your activity when you finish.



When you have submitted your activity you can exit the activity and go to your courses page where you can see a summary of your course so far.

Your 'Progress' is the total score for the activities you have completed so far and your 'Latest score' is the total for your most recent attempt

You will be able to view your latest score and overall progress as a percentage (%) on the 'Courses' homepage.

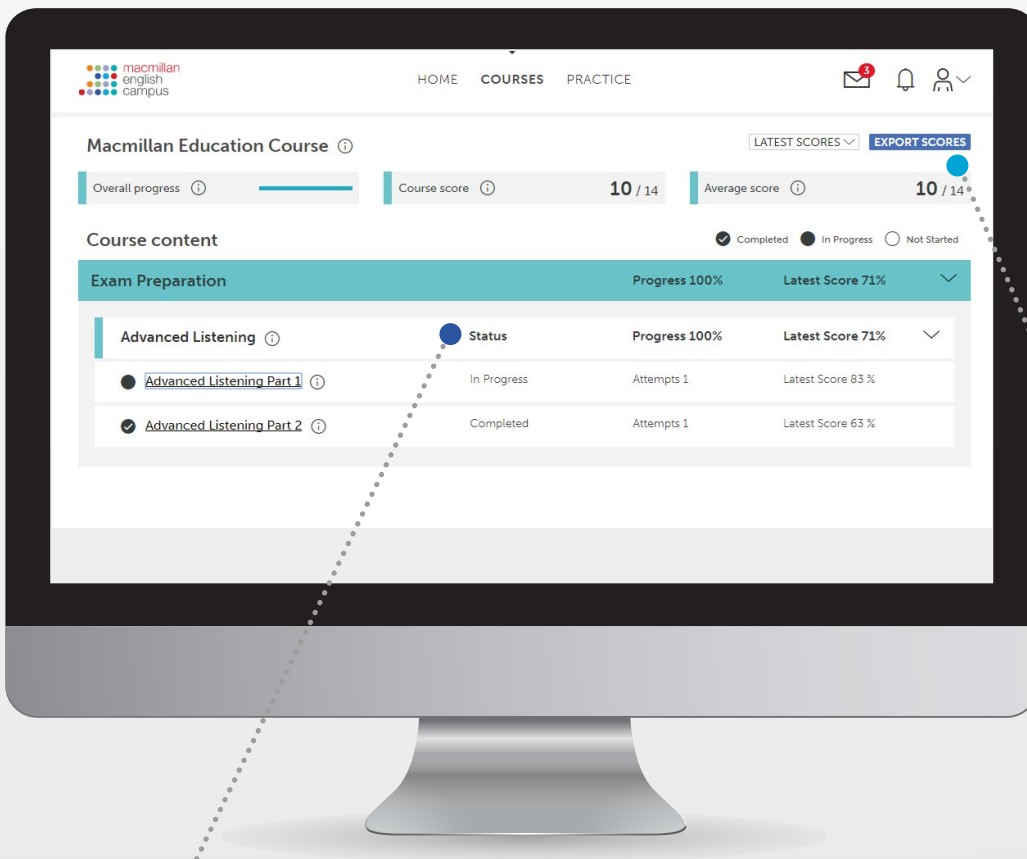

Activities will either show as completed, in progress or not started.

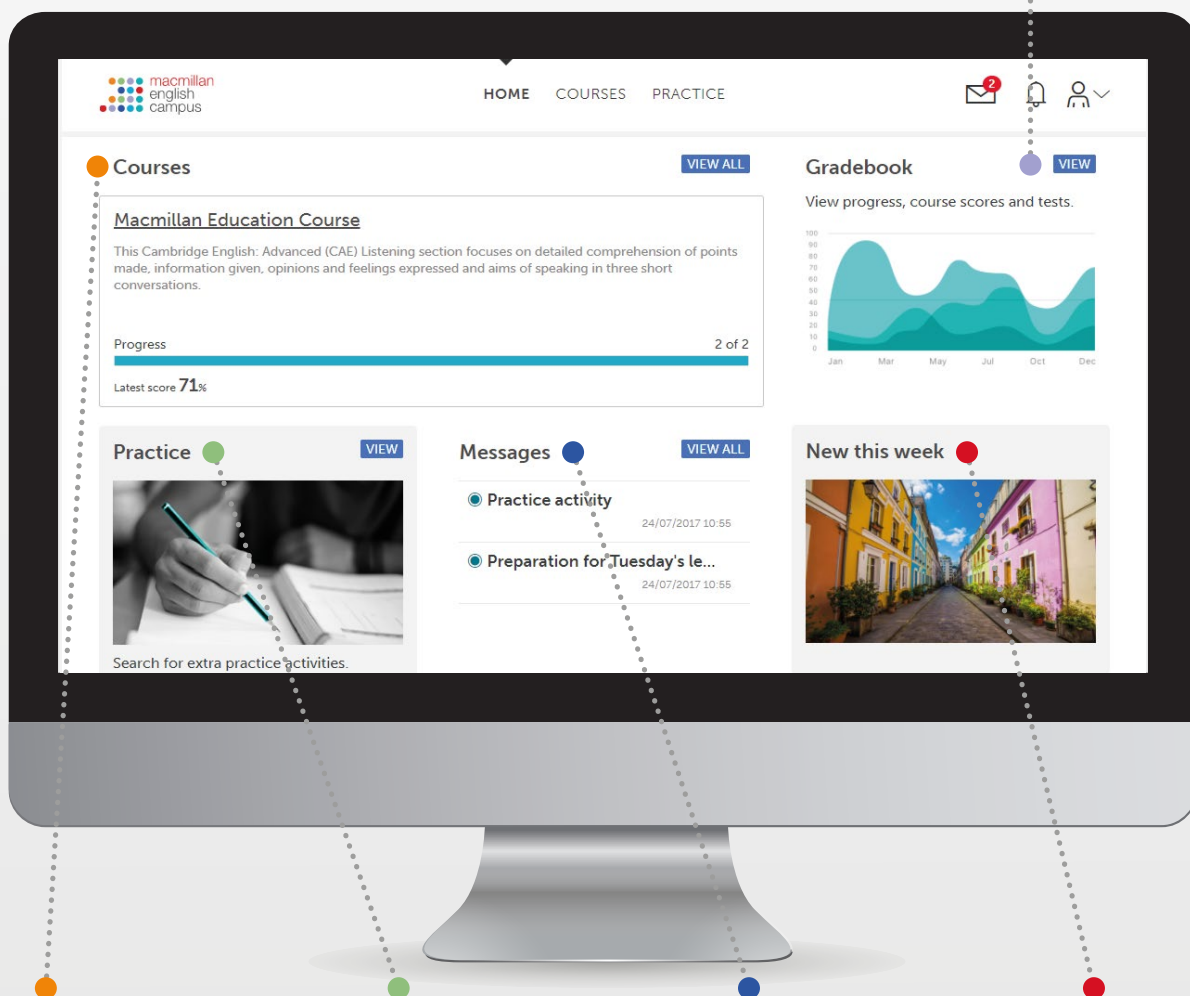
You can download a PDF of your scores by clicking 'Export scores'. The PDF also shows the time you have spent on the activity and the number of times you have attempted it.

Home

When you log into your Macmillan English Campus account you will be able to access your most important information such as your courses, gradebook and the extra practice area.

Click 'View' to access your gradebook and track your progress.



'Courses' shows your assigned courses and progress. You can click on the course name to view your activities and scores.

See your latest practice score for activities you have completed outside of your course.

Read the latest messages from your teacher, send a message or go to your message inbox.

Navigation

Home – go back to home

Courses – access your courses, progress and scores

Practice – search for extra practice activities outside of your assigned course and see your practice scores

Messages – receive and send messages to your teacher

Notifications – check for notifications once your teacher has marked activities

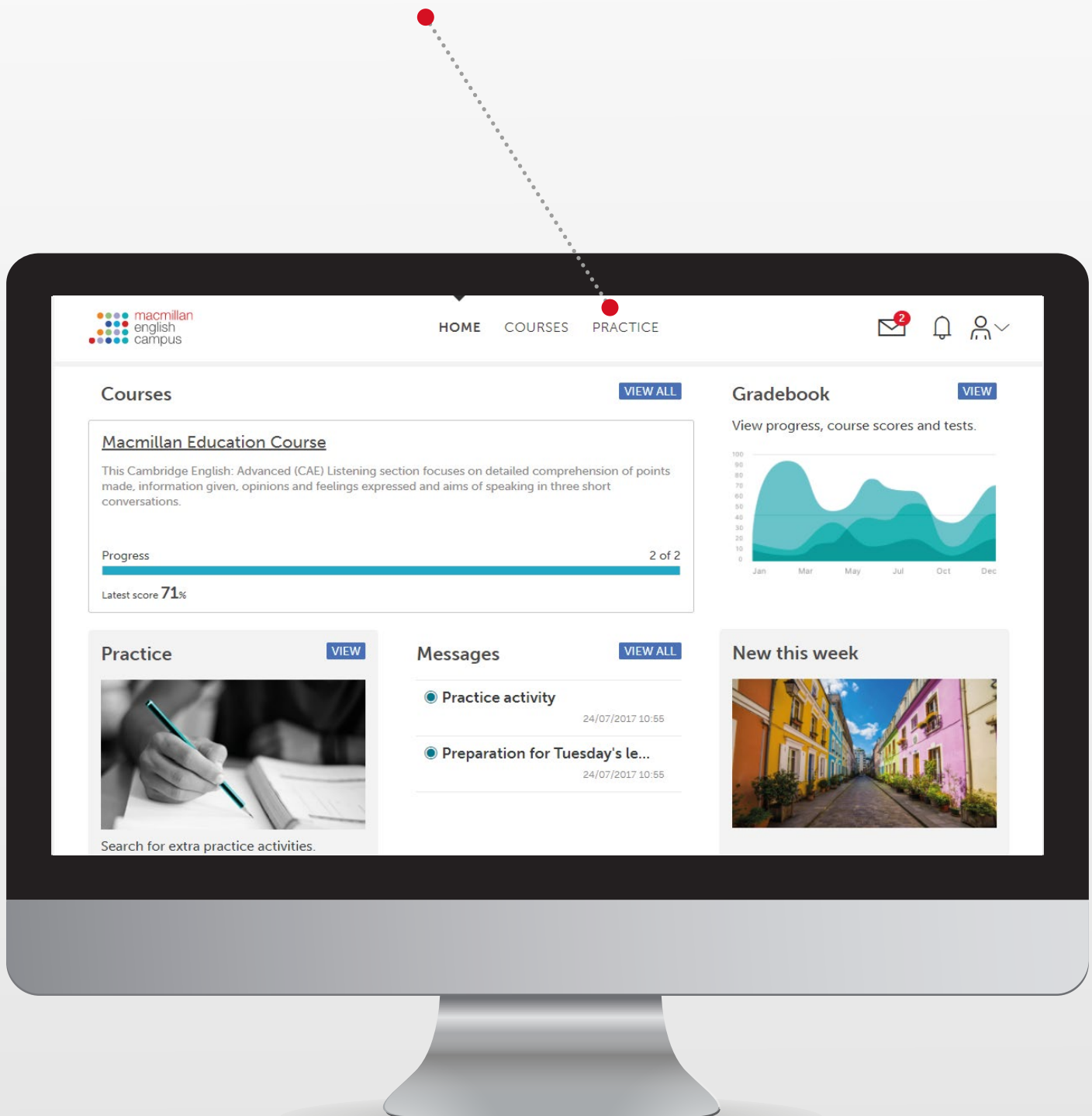

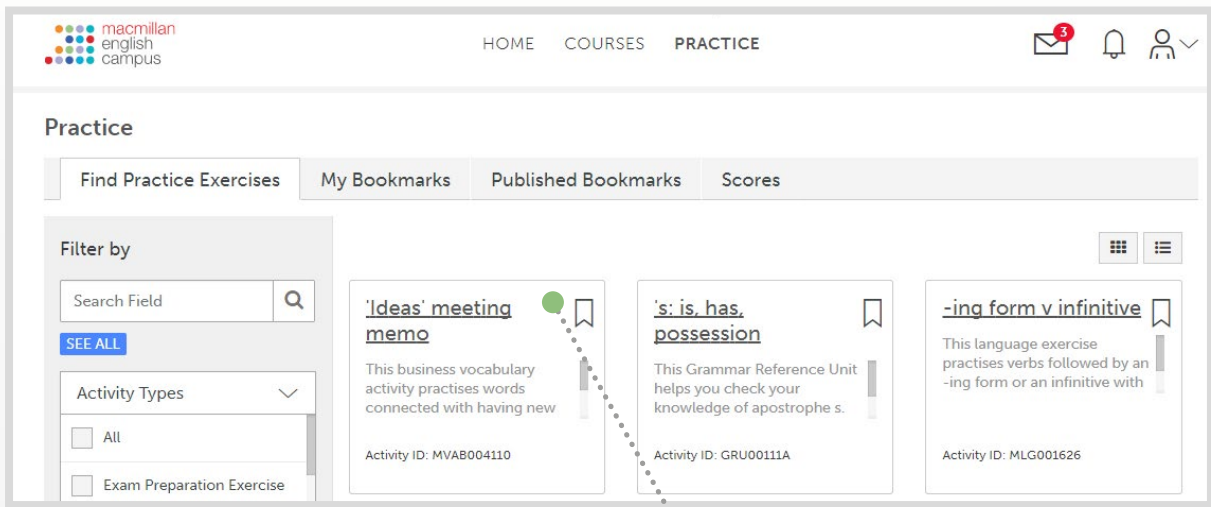

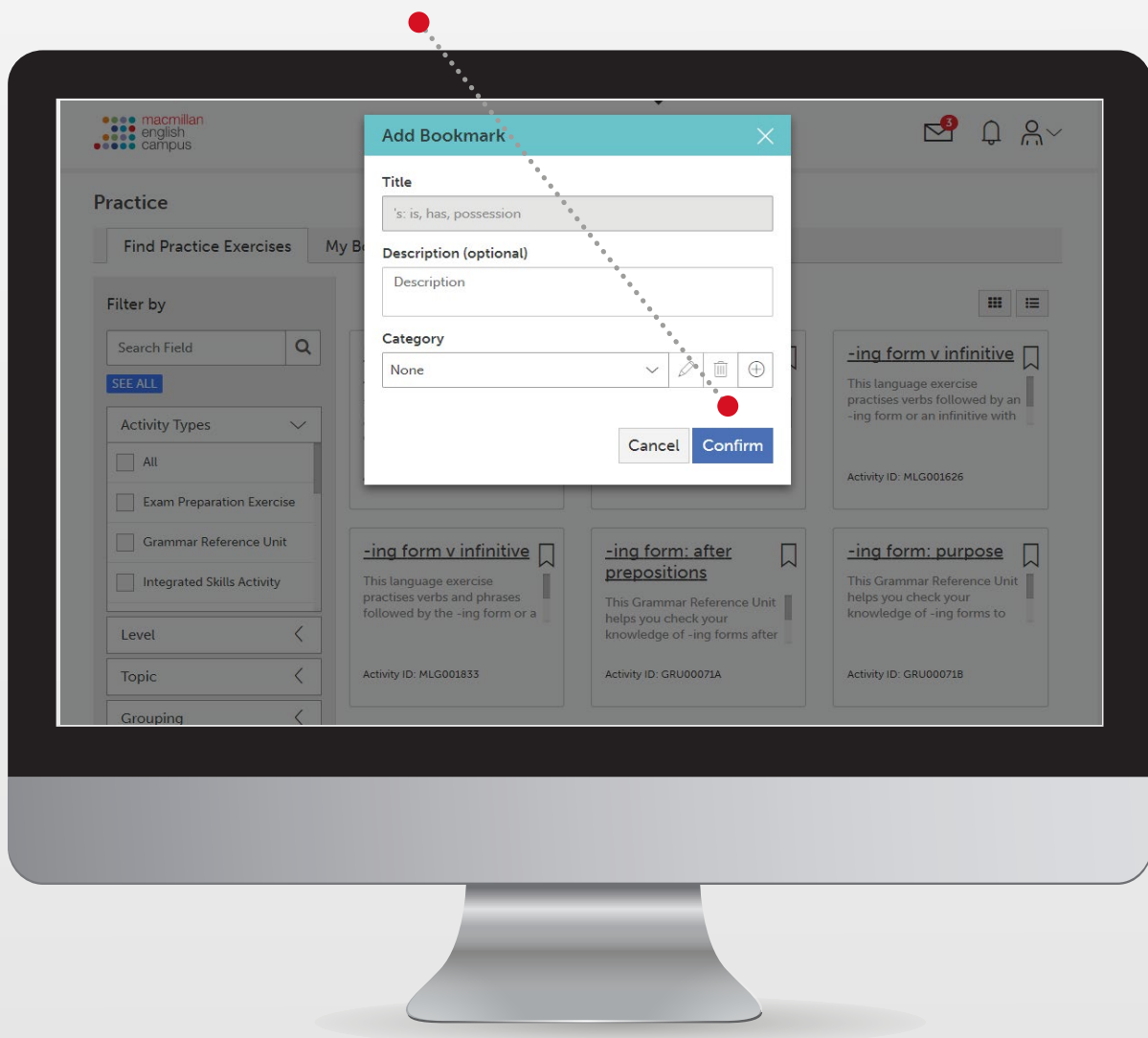
Saving practice activities: bookmarks

You can save practice activities to complete later. These are called bookmarks.

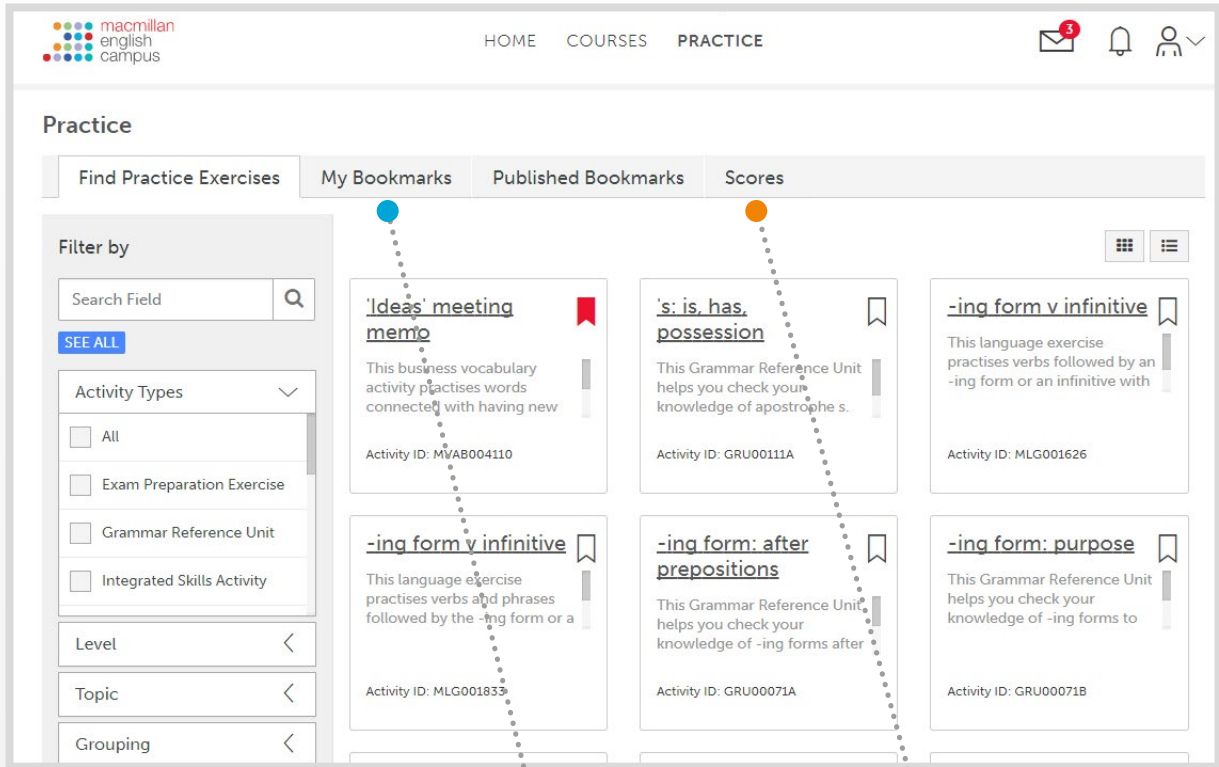


Click on the bookmark icon to save your activity for later.

When you have bookmarked an activity the bookmark icon will turn red.

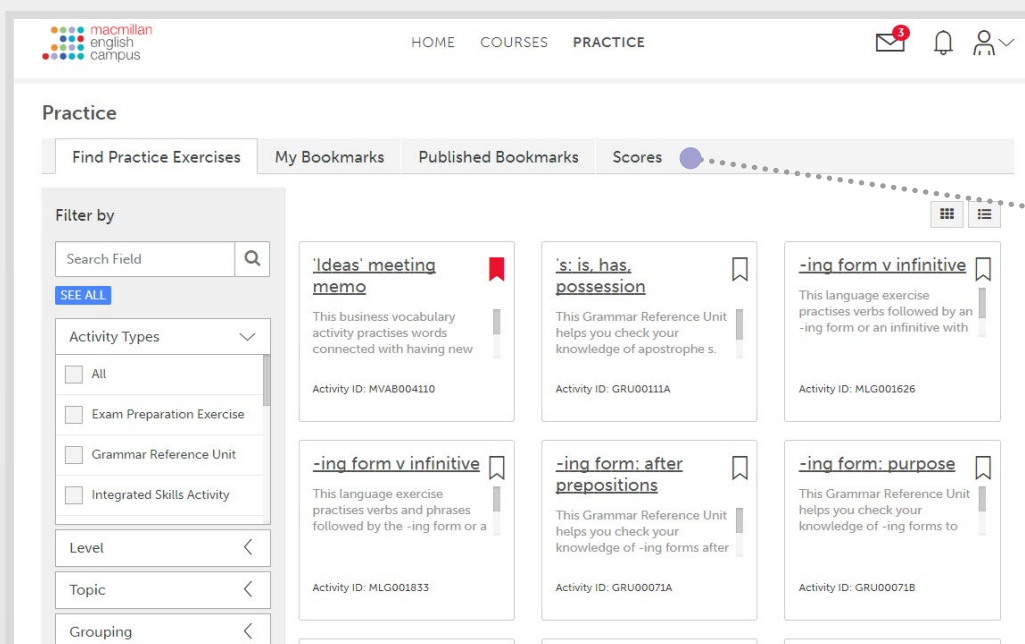


You can find your bookmarked activities by clicking 'My Bookmarks' in the 'Practice' area.

Scores for bookmarked activities can also be found in the 'Practice' area.

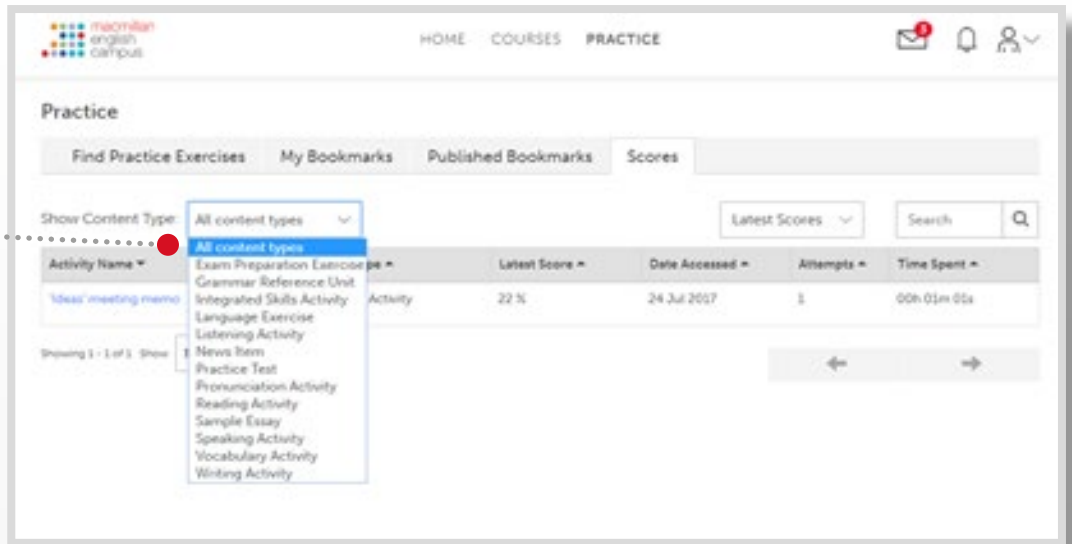
Practice scores

Practice scores are scores for activities that are not part of your course.

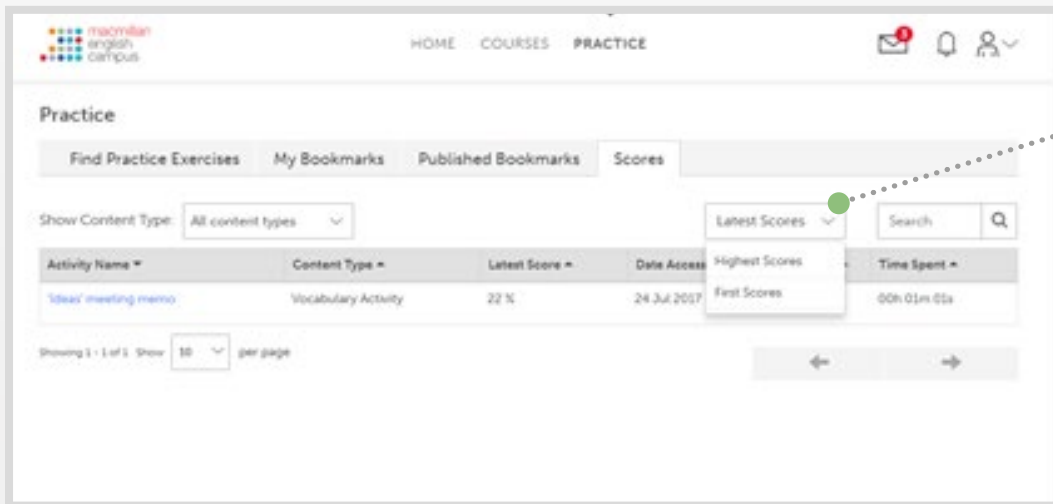

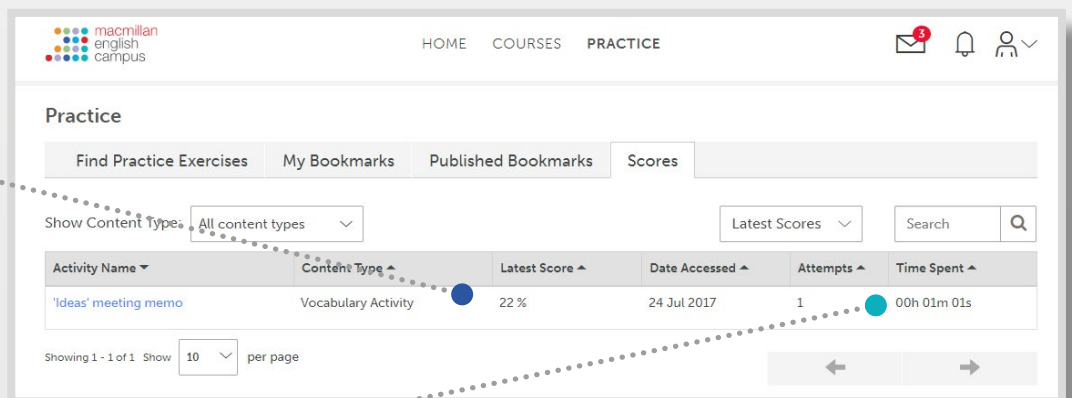

Choose to see your First, Latest or Highest score for each activity.




Scores are shown as a percentage (%).



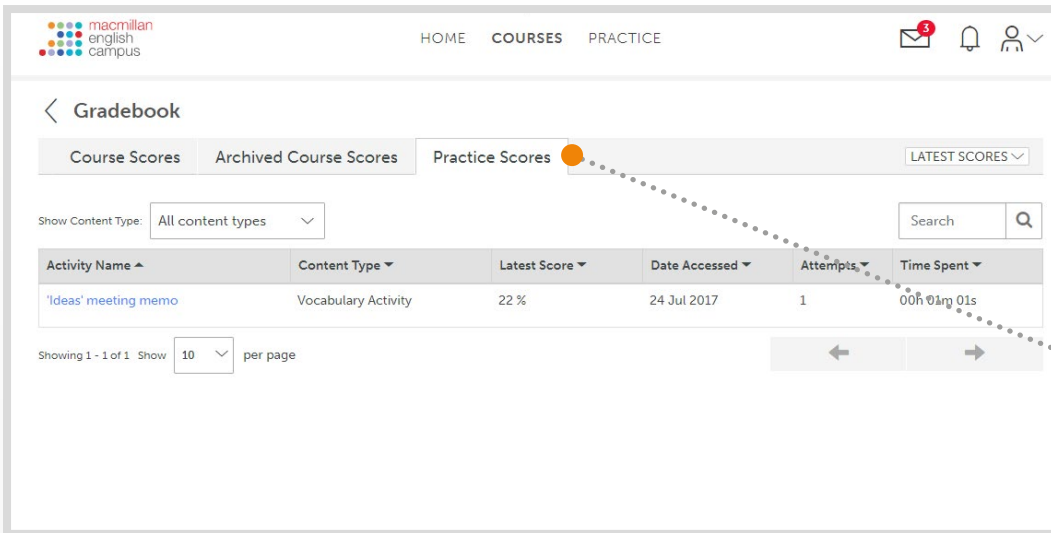

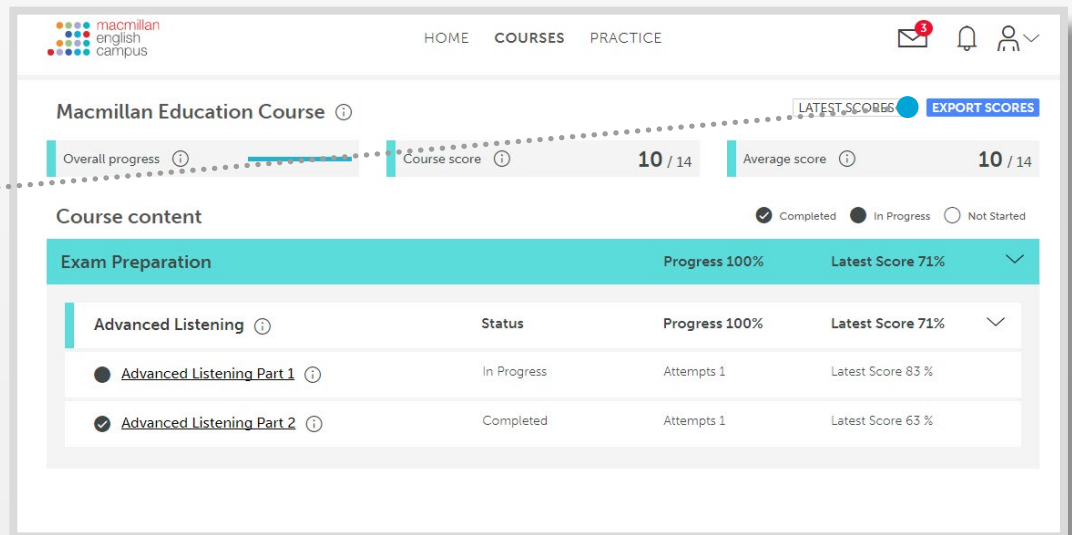
