


You can access your courses via the homepage.



#### **Course view**


Here you can view your:

## **Activity example**


When you click on an activity title, an activity will open like this.





Your 'Progress' is the total score for the activities you have completed so far and your 'Latest score' is the total for your most recent

You will be able to view your latest score and overall progress as a percentage (%) on the 'Courses' homepage.

You can also view your first and highest score for an activity. 'First' is the total score for all your first attempts at each activity and 'Highest' is the total of your best scores.







You can download a PDF of your scores by clicking 'Export scores'. The PDF also shows the time you have spent on the activity and the number of times you have attempted it.









When you log into your Macmillan English Campus account you will be able to access your most important information such as your courses, gradebook and the extra practice area.




'Courses' shows your assigned courses and the course name to view your activities and scores.

Access activities your teacher has bookmarked for you or bookmark your own activities for extra practice.











## Searching for practice activities

This will take you to the practice page.








You can save practice activities to complete later. These are called bookmarks.





When you have bookmarked an activity the bookmark icon will turn red.





#### **Practice scores**

Practice scores are scores for activities that are not part of your course.



















You can see your scores on the English Campus and you can save them on your computer.




